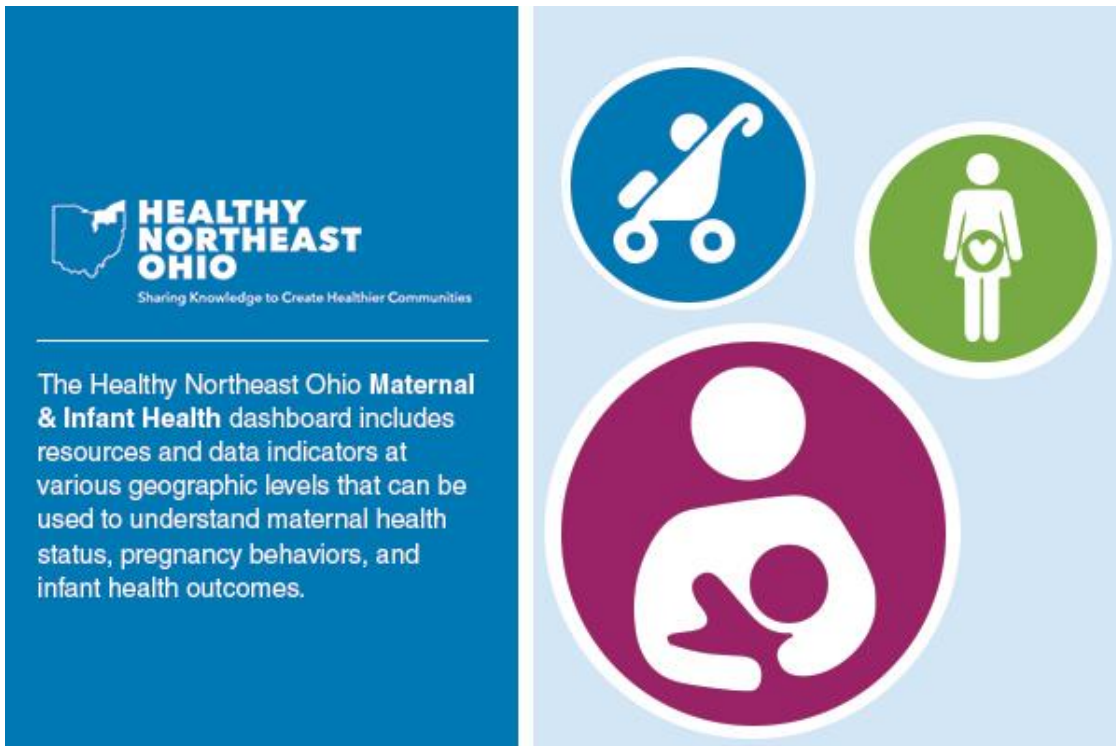

The recently published Maternal & Infant Health dashboard on healthyneo.org includes data indicators at various geographic levels from the Bureau of Vital Statistics at the Ohio Department of Health (ODH), Claritas Consumer Profiles published by Claritas, LLC, and the Ohio Pregnancy Assessment Survey (OPAS) Dashboard.
